

Artwork Checklist - Onbody Artwork

Text

- Have the fonts been outlined/flattened?
- Font size above 6pt?

Images

- Is the artwork high resolution (above 300dpi or vector format)?
- If overprint has been used, please ensure that no images or logos have been lost. (We recommend viewing the artwork as a PDF with overprint preview, if this is applicable)

Colours

- Is the artwork CMYK?
- How many colours have been used?
- Have any pantones been used? (Please see artwork guidelines for more advice on using pantones)
- For **silk screen** print – we recommend using pantone colours where possible and any areas of black should be 100% black
- For **litho print** – Ideally, any areas of black should be set up as C=50%, M=50%, Y=50%, K=100%

Dimensions

- Does the artwork fit in the relevant template?
- For **replicated CD's** please ensure that there is no text across the stacking ring

If artwork is to be printed onto a **silver base**:

- Please check silver base template and ensure that no text runs onto the clear hub. If required, please request fully metalised discs.
